Speaking of records, if you want to hear something beautiful, buy the record recently released by Brunswick, "I'm Riding to Glory." In this recording, Arnold Johnson uses the new Mezzo-Soprano in playing the last chorus. Notice the peculiar beauty of this little solo sax.

The only obstacle hindering the popularizing of this beautiful little instrument among those who cannot transpose readily, has been the lack of music. That was to be expected. Music is never written for an instrument before the instrument is created. *But now a lot of good music is available and the repertoire is being rapidly augmented.*
